Areas of expertise:

What is expected of you?

The trustee will be expected to commit to the following:

- A minimum of 12-15 days per year in fulfilling the role in London
- Draw on your own networks to support and expand Iconic Steps reach and income generation
- Take ownership of one aspect of Iconic Steps to drive forward progressions i.e marketing, business development, bid writing, etc
- Provide support & advice for the leadership team
- Be a positive advocate for the charity and business at all times, including attending key Iconic Steps events
- Have a thorough understanding of the programme of events taking place throughout the year
