THE ONGOING IMPACT OF COST OF LIVING

- Cost of running a voluntary organisation will rise
- Income will be at risk
- Less public sector income
- Increasing demand from service users

- Check budgets are realistic
- Always focus on your public benefit
- Consider new collaborations or ways of working

SUPPORTING STAFF, TRUSTEES AND VOLUNTEERS

- Recruiting staff may be challenging
- Pay will affect recruitment and retention
- Flexible working & supporting wellbeing is key

- Check pay, especially for the lowest paid
- Embed flexible & remote working
- Support & engage your volunteers

KEEPING UP THE PACE ON EQUITY, DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION

- A remaining challenge for many organisations and communities
- Use new data to enrich your understanding
- Advocate for equity
- Reach new audiences

- Take stock of your progress & areas for development
- Ensure you report transparently
- Use the available data



ADAPTING TO POLITICAL CHANGE

- Engaging with the current government
- Political parties are planning for the next election
- Restrictions on being heard
- Stay lawful

- Engage broadly with a range of political parties
- Ensure good governance oversight of risks
- Consider impact of new laws

RESPONDING TO NEW LAWS AND REGULATIONS

- New guidance on charities investments due
- Range of new laws will impact charities big & small
- Get set for new reporting duties
